What is Partners Group Global Value Fund (AUD)?

An Australian managed investment scheme which aims to provide investors with:

- An alternative to global equities, while minimizing exposure to the volatility of the stock market
- Access to a diverse portfolio of private companies that is not normally available to individuals
- Monthly liquidity¹

Who will the Fund appeal to?

Partners Group Global Value Fund (AUD) is suitable for:

- Investors seeking long-term equity growth returns
- Investors who are uncomfortable with the volatility of equities
- Investors who are prepared to have an element of illiquid assets in their portfolio with the aim of delivering long-term growth

Where does it fit?

The Fund can be incorporated into an existing portfolio as:

- Part of the allocation to alternative investments
- An alternative to current global equity managers

What is private equity?


Private equity is investments in non-public companies. Private equity investors keep their investment with the intention of building upon their returns within a defined time period, usually between three and seven years. Private equity managers will normally focus on mature businesses, rather than taking the route of venture capital firms who invest in the start-up stages of a company.

Typically, the decision criteria for investing in a business involve market potential, growth opportunity, long-term sustainability, exit opportunities and most importantly, quality of management.
